Why use Taiga exterior wood?

Our treated wood has an extended useful life compared to whitewood as it is more resistant to rot and insects.

Is Taiga exterior wood safe for garden boxes? Taiga exterior wood is safe to use for garden boxes. All of our treated wood products use preservatives that are regularly evaluated by the Health Canada Pest Management Regulatory Agency. Laboratory studies indicate that there is no cause for concern from uptake of preservative ingredients into fruits or vegetables.

Suitable for freshwater applications?

How do you clean Taiga

Taiga exterior wood is approved for use in fresh water applications.

Is there a difference between green, brown and grey treated wood?

Taiga's exterior wood is treated with the same chemicals, regardless of colour, so there is no difference between choosing one over the other aside from aesthetic preference. Research suggests that colour is a consumer preference.


